### Day 5: “Light of the Heart of Christ, dispel the darkness of my heart”

**Fruit:** Allow the LIGHT of Christ to enlighten all aspects of my life, in such a way that I can only live in the truth before Him and others. Decide to bring his light to all the people and circumstances in my life.

#### **Petition:**

Lord Jesus, give me the grace to know you more intimately, to enter into your heart and experience your personal love for me. Jesus, just as you love me, I ask you for this grace:  
Make me fall passionately in love with you!

#### **Gospel:**

*“Then they came to Jericho. And as He was leaving Jericho with His disciples and a large crowd, a blind beggar named Bartimaeus, the son of Timaeus, was **sitting by the road**. When he heard that it was Jesus the Nazarene, he began to cry out and say, **“Jesus, Son of David, have mercy on me!”** Many were sternly telling him to be quiet, but he kept **crying out all the more**, “Son of David, have mercy on me!” And Jesus stopped and said, **“Call him here.”** So they called the blind man, saying to him, **“Take courage, stand up! He is calling for you.”** Throwing aside his cloak, **he jumped up and came to Jesus**. And answering him, Jesus said, **“What do you want Me to do for you?”** And the blind man said to Him, **“Master, I want to regain my sight!”** And Jesus said to him, **“Go; your faith has made you well.”** Immediately he regained his sight and began following Him on the road”. 2. How can you be the light of Christ for others? How can you bring his message of salvation to others? Is there anything concrete you're able to and want to do? A strong desire of your heart?
